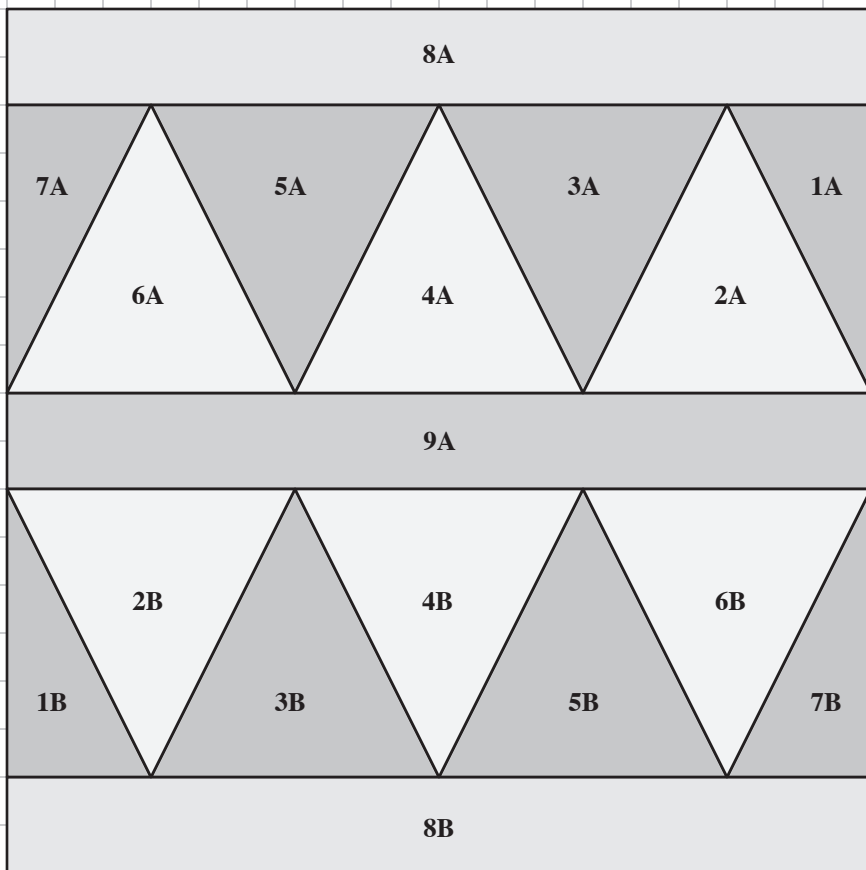

Refer to the Cutting List on Page 3 to cut the fabric pieces.

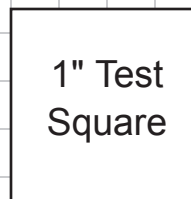
## PIECING THE BLOCK

## ZIG ZAG BORDER

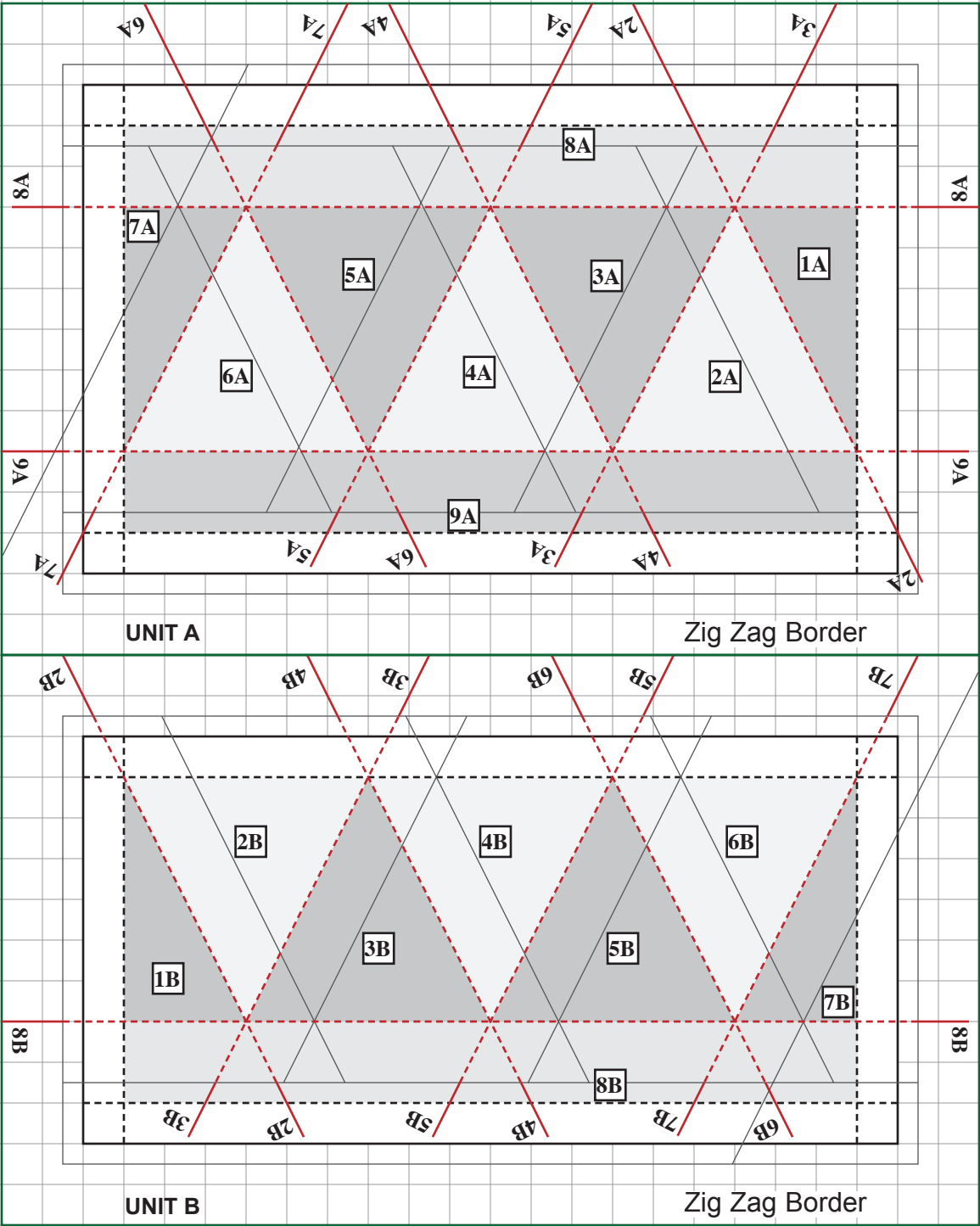

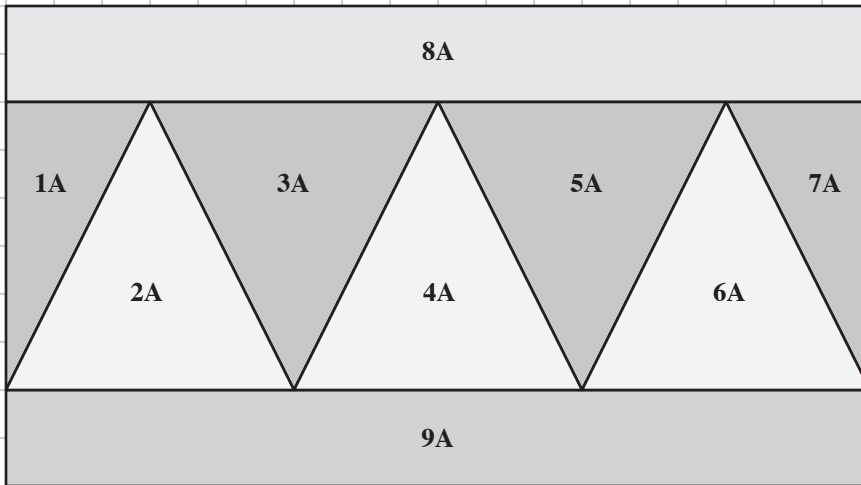

## CUTTING LIST

Location	Size to Cut
1A, 7A	1¾" x 2⅜"
2A, 4A, 6A	2⅞" x 2⅜"
3A, 5A	2⅞" x 2⅜"
8A, 9A	5¼" x 1¼"
1B, 7B	1¾" x 2⅜"
2B, 4B, 6B	2⅞" x 2⅜"
3B, 5B	2⅞" x 2⅜"
8B	5¼" x 1¼"

Trace Locations #1A and 2A on freezer paper to make templates. Layer the fabrics for (1A, 7A) and (1B, 7B) right sides together to cut mirror images.

For less fabric waste, cut triangle units from 2⅞" strips.

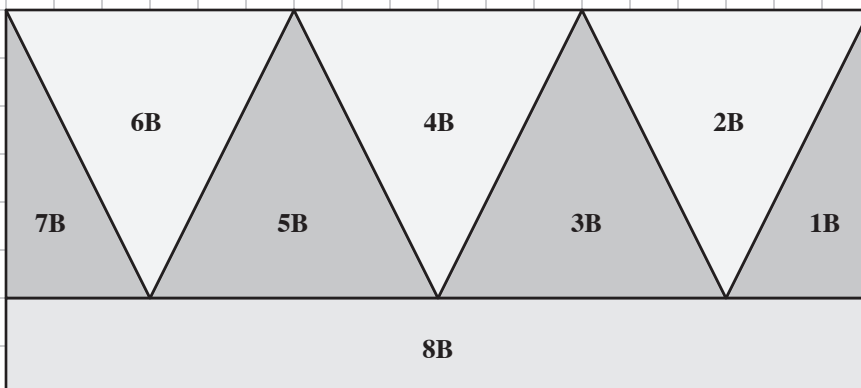


## ZIG ZAG BORDER
