

This sturdy seam guide adheres to your sewing machine to help you sew your seams and hems faster, straighter, and more evenly. It's also useful for a variety of piecing techniques, such as sewing a square from corner to corner without needing to mark a line on the fabric. It's made from flexible plastic that is easy to cut, customize, and reposition as needed to fit your machine. You won't know how you ever lived without it!



The Extension is no longer available, but you can easily make your own if the line in front of the needle is not long enough for the block units. Simply draw a red line down the center of a ruled index card. Laminate the card or cover it with clear packaging tape. Line it up with the red sewing line on the Seam Guide and tape in place.


No matter what piecing techniques you use, the smooth surface and longer, easy-to-see seam allowance markings on the Ultimate Seam Guide will result in more accurate seam allowances and a more enjoyable sewing experience. In addition to the multiple seam allowance markings, the many features include: sewing diagonal seams quickly without marking or pinning, paper piecing with the fabric on top of the paper, using the repositionable guide bars for strip-piecing four-patch blocks, half-square triangles and more. The seam guide can be trimmed easily on all sides for a custom fit.



**6" BIAS EDGE™ Ruler and Marking Template**

Make half-square and quarter-square triangle blocks from fabric strips using this light-weight, easy to handle, multi-purpose ruler. Simply sew down both sides of fabric strips and use the markings on the ruler to quickly cut oversized squares that can be trimmed to the exact size after pressing. Use the template for marking sewing lines for shaded four patch blocks, drafting patterns on graph paper, and marking mitered corners. 1/16" markings for more accuracy when working with miniature or more challenging blocks. Additional instructions included for other uses. Make blocks up to 5" finished.



### **CONFETTI - 16" x 16" or 40" x 40"**

This miniature or wall size quilt is much easier than it looks. It starts out with 1 1/2" or 3" fabric strips and is pieced in a bargello style similar to the Sunshine & Shadow quilt except on a smaller scale. The squares finish at 3/8" or 1". Choose 3 fabrics from light to dark, 3 accent fabrics, and a border.

### **PINWHEEL STARS - 60" x 72"**

Learn this easy paper piecing method while making the floating star blocks and pieced border for this lap size quilt. Choose a light background and a variety of medium, dark, and contrast fabrics for the quilt shown. Vellum foundation paper is recommended for easier construction. Step-by-step cutting, piecing and assembly instructions are included.

## REVERSE PAPER PIECING

New foundation paper piecing technique with less fabric waste!



### **DOUBLE FEATHERED STAR - 35" x 35"**

Learn a new way to paper piece while making this medallion style wall quilt. Choose fabrics to coordinate with a multi-color print for easy fabric selection. For a scrappy quilt, use 6 or more fabrics for the feathers. Vellum foundation paper is recommended for easier construction. Make the quilt as shown, choose the optional center, or use the block as a center medallion for a larger quilt. A diagram is included for experimenting with different colorways.

## NEW PATTERNS

### **AMERICANA STARS - 58" x 58"**

All of the pieced blocks for this medallion style quilt are made using half-square triangle paper which is a quick, easy, and accurate method for constructing the block units and eliminates the need to mark sewing lines or square up blocks.


By using Sew-On-The-Line™ templates, the block units for this quilt can be sewn quickly and accurately without needing a special ruler or having to carefully align the seams for a 1/4" seam allowance. Fabrics used are from the color wheel. You may use any color combination.

## FANCY FEATHERED STAR

If you have always wanted to make a Feathered Star quilt, but thought they were too difficult or only for advanced quilters, this is the pattern for you. Over 80 illustrations take you step-by-step from start to finish using quick-piecing techniques. Additional instructions included for changing the block size, changing the block center, and more. Only 5 fabrics needed. Use a Seam Guide for more accurate seam allowances and to sew diagonal corner pieces without marking.

## BAUBLES & BEADS

At first glance this quilt appears to be made with 2 sizes of nine patch blocks; but it is actually made from strip-pieced four patch blocks trimmed on one side, strip sets, and sashing. Choose a variety of fabrics from two color families for the look shown. Avoid obvious one-way prints. Save time cutting, pinning, and pressing!

This is the perfect pattern for learning the block piecing techniques used with the Ultimate Seam Guide.



## SUNSHINE & SHADOW

Choose 6 fabrics ranging from dark to light and cut into six 5" strips and one 2 1/2" strip. Sew, cut, and sew again and you will soon have more than twelve hundred 2" finished squares sewn together for a full-size quilt. A fun and easy piecing technique. Choose monochromatic colors as shown, or use a rainbow of colors. From floral prints to batiks to blended fabrics, this quilt will be sure to please.

## PINEAPPLE SPLIT – 24" x 24"

Using fabric strips sewn around a center square, see how easily you can make these quarter pineapple blocks 4 at a time without using paper or templates. Learn a new way to paper piece the border blocks with little fabric waste and less frustration than the traditional way. Once you learn this easy technique you will never paper piece simple blocks the old way again! Pattern includes tips for making different block sizes and cutting instructions for a lap size quilt.



## LOG CABIN BLOCK

Learn a new way to foundation paper piece with this quick and easy log cabin block pattern. No need to turn the paper over or hold it up to a light. Use a Seam Finder™ to line up the extended lines on the pattern with the needle for sewing. Includes full-size pattern in 4 block sizes, bonus 2 1/2" miniature flag block, 3 sizes grid paper with instructions for drafting your own log cabin style blocks, and reverse paper piecing pros, cons, and solutions.



## BLOCKS ON POINT

If you want to try a more challenging block than the log cabin block, try these blocks with 45° angles. Includes full-size patterns for six 4 1/4" blocks that can be used alone or as the on-point center of a 6" finished block, bonus 2 1/2" miniature framed square block, and 2 sizes grid paper with instructions for drafting your own on-point style blocks.



Increase the block size for a larger quilt. Omit the background fabric for a straight cabin. Step-by-step illustrated instructions guide you through the piecing process.



## SPINNING CABIN

Choose a variety of fat quarters in 4 color families to make the quilt shown, or use a large selection of leftover fabrics for a scrappier look. The 1" pieced border may be strip-pieced for speed or reverse paper pieced for more accuracy using the bonus template included. Make just four 6" blocks for a matching pillow. This pattern includes 4 preprinted foundation papers to get you started.


## GEESE AMONG THE STARS

Cutting and reverse paper piecing the blocks for this quilt is much easier than it looks. Choose a variety of fat quarters in lights and darks to make the quilt shown, or use a large selection of leftover fabrics for a scrappier look. Each fat quarter will make three 6" blocks and up to four 3" blocks. For easy fabric selection choose fabrics to coordinate with a multi-colored border. The yardage given is enough fabric to make both the lap size and miniature quilts. Easy rotary cutting and binding instructions are included.

## EVERYDAY BISCUITS

Choose 32 assorted fat quarters of '30s prints or brushed plaid fabrics to make this 42" x 60" soft, puffy "biscuit" quilt with raggy seams. The "biscuit" look is achieved by using extra-loft batting and making tiny tucks in the slightly larger top square of fabric. Sew the squares with back sides together, clip the seams, then wash and dry to fluff the seams. Step-by-step instructions included for a matching 16" pillow with velcro closure and a 17 1/2" x 21" doll quilt made from scraps. Easy enough for beginning quilters.



## COUNTRY BLOCKS SAMPLER

This pattern was designed to introduce you to some of the many block patterns that can be made using the rag quilting technique. It includes a variety of full-size applique and quilting motifs that can be used for other projects in addition to this quilt. Many of the blocks can be pieced and quilted in one step, saving time and thread. Choose just one or two of the blocks for a simpler quilt. The design possibilities are endless. A tip is included for keeping most of the lint out of the washer and dryer.



## BUILD A NAME WITH CHENILLE

Combine chenille with rag quilting to build a name one square at a time. Or use all of the letters and numbers for an alphabet and numbers quilt. Simply layer 3 fabric squares on top of a backing, batting, and base fabric, center the letter on top, and sew diagonal lines spaced about 1/4" apart through all layers. Cut between the stitching lines of the top layers, assemble blocks, clip seams, and wash to fluff seams. Double the size of the 2 3/4" letters included for the 7" blocks shown. Use the letters and numbers for appliques or in other projects.

## RAG BOUQUET

Take your rag quilting to the next level with this fun, frayed-edge applique quilt. After learning this easy technique, you will be able to turn almost any applique design into rag quilt blocks. This quilt was inspired by Susan H. Garman's quilt "Bouquets for A New Day", a 2008 Block of the Month for thequiltshow.com. The block is a modified design from EQ5. To make a larger quilt with more blocks choose any designs of your choice and follow the detailed instructions included for this block.

## HOMESPUN TWIST


Choose a variety of homespun or brushed plaid fabrics from several different color families to make this 45" x 63" rag quilt. Batting is optional. One fat quarter is needed for each 9" finished block, making it easy to figure yardage for a custom size quilt. Simply cut and layer squares of fabric, sew and quilt the layers at the same time, assemble the blocks, add a pieced edging from scraps, clip the seams, wash and dry and you're done. A tip is included for keeping most of the lint out of the washer and dryer.




