

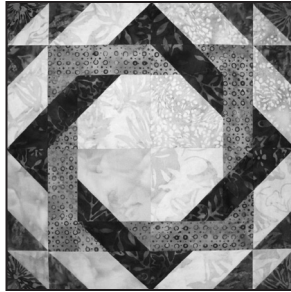
# Shop Hop Block

Finished Block Size: 12" x 12"

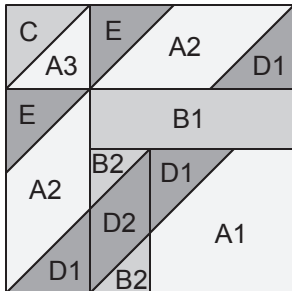
### Materials

- 6" x 8½" each of 4 light for A
- 4" x 17½" medium print for B
- 5" x 5" medium print for C
- 7" x 15" dark print for D
- 5" x 10" dark print for E

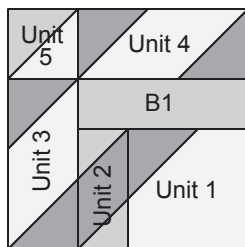


### Cutting Chart

Piece	Number to Cut	Size to Cut
A1	1 each of 4 light	3½" x 3½"
A2	2 each of 4 light	4¾" x 2¼"
A3	1 each of 4 light	2¼" x 2¼"
B1	4 medium	4¾" x 1¾"
B2	8 medium	1¾" x 1¾"
C	4 medium	2¼" x 2¼"
D1	12 dark	2¼" x 2¼"
D2	4 dark	3½" x 1¾"
E	8 dark	2¼" x 2¼"

### Block Piecing

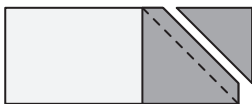
All block units are pieced using the stitch and flip method.



Place square in position and mark diagonal sewing line.



Stitch on marked line.

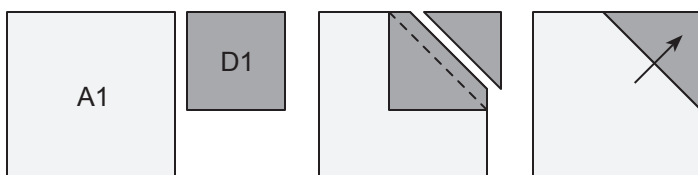


Trim excess fabric.



Press in direction of arrow.

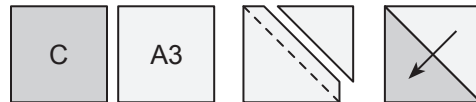
### Unit 3: Make 4, 1 each light fabric A.



### Unit 4: Make 4, 1 each light fabric A.



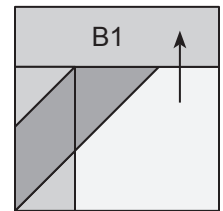
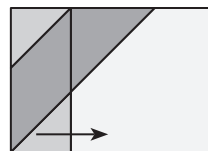
### Unit 5: Make 4.



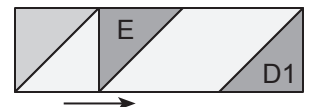
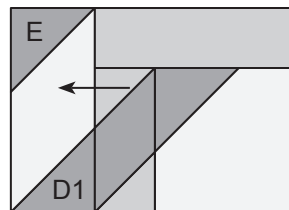
### Block Assembly

Refer to the diagrams to assemble the units. Make 4 each using a different light fabric in each quarter block.

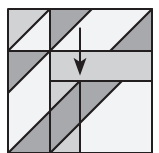
1. Sew Unit 1 to Unit 2. Press to Unit 1.
2. Sew B1 to Unit 1/Unit 2.



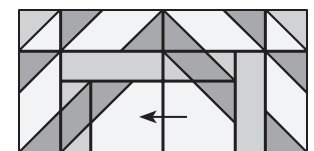
3. Sew Unit 3 to B1/Unit 2, matching light fabric.
4. Sew Unit 4 to Unit 5, matching light fabric.



5. Sew Unit 4/Unit 5 to Unit 3/B1, matching light fabric, to make quarter block.



6. Sew 2 quarter blocks together to make pairs. Make 2 pairs.



7. Sew pairs together to complete block assembly. Open seam at center and press counterclockwise on front.
